Last July, St. Elizabeth achieved a significant milestone and met a longtime system goal when Edgewood became our first hospital to receive the prestigious 5-star rating from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Today, we are excited to reveal that not only did we reach that milestone again this year, but we raised the bar even higher for excellence for our patients and community. CMS has just announced that both Edgewood and Dearborn have earned the coveted 5-star rating this year!

What does it mean to be a CMS 5-star hospital?

- The Best of the Best in Healthcare: Five-star is the highest rating given by CMS. Last year in 2023, it was achieved by only five hospitals in Kentucky, four in Greater Cincinnati, 14 in Indiana and 483 nationwide. This year, only 13% of hospitals in the country were rated 5-star.
- Highest Quality Rating: CMS 5-star hospitals are recognized as providing elite-level quality of care, based on numerous performance measures.
- Seamless Experience: These hospitals excel in patient satisfaction scores, reflecting positive patient experiences and high standards of care.
- Clinical Outcomes: They have superior clinical outcomes, including lower mortality and readmission rates, indicating effective and efficient care.
- Safety: Five-star hospitals consistently perform well in safety measures, such as preventing infections and avoiding errors.
- Innovation and Excellence: They demonstrate high proficiency in administering timely and effective treatments for a wide range of conditions.
- Patient-Centered Care: A hallmark of 5-star hospitals is their emphasis on patientcentered care practices, such as effective communication and respect for patient preferences.
- Preventive Care: They are proactive in providing preventive care services, such as vaccinations and screenings, to maintain community health.
- Guiding Patients: Perhaps most importantly, CMS ratings are a valuable tool for patients and their families in helping them to make well-informed decisions about their healthcare. They signal the highest standard of care.
