- Prefer to receive your flu vaccine through your physician/other healthcare clinic or pharmacy, please submit your documentation to the Volunteer Office.
- Choose to not receive the flu shot, you will be ineligible to volunteer from December 5, 2024 – April 1, 2025.

Respiratory Infection Season Visitor Restrictions

St. Elizabeth Healthcare Respiratory Infection Season Visitor Restrictions will officially begin Friday, Nov. 1. As in the past, we will monitor respiratory illnesses in our community, such as influenza, COVID-19 and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV). Updates will be provided throughout the season.

Restrictions from General Visiting

- All persons with respiratory symptoms (cough, runny nose, sore throat, fever, and/or sneezing).
- · All children under the age of 14.

Visitor restrictions in Maternal Child and Infant areas vary.

- Visitation exceptions should be rare and approved by the Nursing Supervisor or charge nurse on the specific unit.
- Hand sanitizer and tissues are available in lobbies and ED waiting areas.

Respiratory Illness Information

Influenza is spread primarily through coughing and sneezing of respiratory droplets, or through touching contaminated surfaces. Adults may be able to spread influenza to others from one day before symptoms to approximately five days after symptoms start. Children and those with weakened immune systems may be infectious and able to spread flu to others for 10 or more days after symptoms begin.

COVID-19 spreads when an infected person breathes out droplets and very small particles that contain the virus. Most often this causes respiratory symptoms that can feel much like a cold, the flu, or pneumonia. Other parts of your body may also be affected by the disease. Most people with COVID-19 have mild symptoms, but some people become severely ill.

RSV is spread by direct or close contact with infected secretions. Symptoms are usually mild, cold-like symptoms and most people recover in a week or two. RSV can be especially severe in infants and older adults.
