- Evaluate and assess above information to create a plan of care.
- Complete patient's assessment using remote access tools; document all applicable notes (admission, brief prognosis, etc.) in eCareManager®.
- Determine health status and identify differential diagnoses based on history and clinical findings.
- Use data from appropriate invasive and non-invasive monitoring devices to titrate therapy in the ICU.
- Use patient population management tools found in eCareManager
- Demonstrate ability to create and document physician approved diagnosis
- Initiate advanced cardiac life support until the code team arrives; supports remote code team as requested.
- Stabilize critically ill patients with impending or active organ failure (respiratory, cardiac, neurologic, hepatic,
